

OLGA CLARK IS ALSO A WINNER

Miss Clark Wins The Wrist Watch Offered By The Star-Bulletin

With new records set in every event but one, the combined swimming meet held at the Outrigger Canoe club by the University of Hawaii and the Outrigger swimmers was a cheerful event for the small but interesting group of spectators who gathered at Waikiki beach yesterday morning.

A. E. (Toots) Minvielle, O. C. C. swimmer and three times winner of the Castle one mile open swim held annually as the main event of the Outrigger Canoe club swims, made it the fourth time when he romped away with the race in the new record time of 30 minutes and 38 seconds. The old record was 33 minutes 40 6-10 seconds. Jimmy Hurd, W. Craw and Weight, all of the U. of H., finished in the order named after Minvielle.

A calm sea and no driving wind made it possible for such good times to be made in all the events of the day.

Miss Clark Wins

The public baths swim for women, the event sponsored by The Honolulu Star-Bulletin and in which the winner receives a platinum and silver wrist watch, was won by Olga Clark with Mildred Slaght Hooper and Gladys Slaght second and third respectively. The time of Miss Clark was 19 minutes 45 2-10 seconds.

The half mile race for men over 30 years of age saw Clifford Gessler upset the veteran Bob Askew, his only competitor, winning easily by at least a hundred yards. Gessler appeared not in the least tired at the conclusion of the race.

Close Contest

A race that drew much applause was the quarter mile swim for O. C. C. women and the University senior mermaids. The O. C. C. winners, L. Furtado and R. Howland, the race ending in a tie, burst forth into a terrific dash for the finish line when some 10 yards away and both touched the line at exactly the same time. The time, 13 minutes 20 3-10 seconds, broke the old record of 14 minutes flat.
