

# SEVENTY-FIVE FOR HAWAII

## Opening Meet March 1 In University of Ha- waii Pool

**E**NTRIES closed for the annual indoor Hawaiian A. A. U. swimming championships last night, and exclusive of the relay teams, 75 sent in their names to "Pump" Searle, coach of the University of Hawaii team, under whose auspices the meet is to be held in the University pool.

There will be four meets to determine winners, the first is scheduled for next Thursday, and as trials will be necessary in several of the events, the time set for these trials is Tuesday February 27 at 7:30 o'clock.

A brand new lighting system has been installed at the tank, also seats provided for 500 spectators, while 300 more can be accommodated but must stand.

### MANY CLUBS ENTER

Clubs represented by their stars include the U. S. Army, the Citywide, Outrigger, 40 and 8, Palama A. C., Nuuanu Y, Iolani School, with the usual large number of unattached swimmers.

Trials will be necessary in the diving, where 11 have entered and but six can qualify, the 50 yards freestyle for girls under 13, 50 yards freestyle for boys under 13, and the 100 yards breaststroke novice for men.
