

STAR MERMAIDS IN 220 EVENT

Four Hawaiian Championships Will Be At Stake In Races This Evening

Four Hawaiian championships are listed among the 14 events on the program for the first of a series of indoor championship meets to be held at the University of Hawaii pool at 7:30 o'clock this evening.

The meets are being staged under the auspices of the University of Hawaii and Theodore (Pump) Searle, chairman of the committee in charge, expects to have a good turnout of fans.

Keen competition for team honors is expected to develop between the Army and University of Hawaii teams. The Army mermen carried off the outdoor championship last year and has an exceptionally strong team in the running again this season.

The Citywide club is placing a team in the competition and the 40 & 8 club will also make a bid for honors.

Feature Events

The championship events scheduled for this evening are the 10 foot springboard diving, 500 yard freestyle for men, 100 yard breaststroke for women and the 220 yard freestyle for women.

The 220 yard freestyle event for women is expected to be one of the most interesting events of the evening. Olga Clark, local girl who won many swimming honors in mainland competition last year, is entered in this event and is one of the favorites. Others who will compete are Mildred Hooper, Gladys Slaght, Jean Pope, M. Morse and K. Bull. All of these mermaids have been training hard in preparation for the meet and fast time is expected in the 220 event.

The ticket office at the University of Hawaii tank will open at 5 p. m. today.

The Program

The events scheduled tonight are: 100 yard backstroke novice for women, 100 yard freestyle for boys under 16, 200 yard relay open for women, 300 yard medley relay novice for men, 200 yard relay open, 220 yard freestyle novice men, 100 yards breaststroke Hawaiian championship for women, 300 yard medley junior men, 100 yard breaststroke junior men, 100 yard breaststroke novice men, diving, 500 yard freestyle Hawaiian championship, 220 yard freestyle Hawaiian championship for women, 50 yard freestyle for girls under 13, 50 yards freestyle boys under 13.
