

A.A.U. Volley League Plans Opening April 16

A. A. Kempa, chairman of the committee, today announced that the 1934 Hawaiian senior A. A. U. volleyball league will commence on April 16 with games at the Central Y and Palama gymnasium. It was decided at a meeting of the volleyball committee yesterday.

The committee which was appointed by Joseph R. Farrington, president of the local A. A. U., is composed of the following: A. A. Kempa, chairman; A. K. Powlison, R. N. Benny, W. S. Wood, T. C. B. Gibson and Lt. J. Dillon.

Games will be played on Monday and Thursday nights at the Central Y. M. C. A. and Palama gymnasiums. A doubleheader was planned to be played at each court on alternate nights.

The University of Hawaii was invited to stage some of the contests at the university gym, allowing students holding athletic association season tickets to attend the games free of charge.
