

# Hurd Displays Class In 100 Yard Freestyle Swim

The best time made in a 100 yard freestyle swim in Honolulu in a long time was turned in by Jimmy Hurd of the University of Hawaii at the university pool last night.

Hurd swam the century in 54.8 seconds in the trials for the Hawaiian indoor championships, the finals of which will be held at the same tank Friday evening.

The university swimmer set a fast pace from the start and finished about eight yards ahead of his nearest rival. Lake, Timberlake and Tannehill of the army finished behind Hurd in the order named. Then came Craw of the university, followed by Waidlich, another army swimmer.

The university goes into the final meet of the four meet series with the slim lead of six points over the Army team. However, Army is already conceded five or more points in the one meter board diving event. Alvarez of the Army displayed great form in the diving trials last night.

A great race should develop in the breaststroke championship swim for men as Desha, King and Powers of the university will find plenty of competition when they run up against Lt. Webster of the Army and Harris, 40 & 8 Club ace.
