

DIVING EVENT IS A FEATURE

Meet Opens At 7:45 o'Clock
At Natatorium With 1,500
Meter Swim

Hawaii's leading men and women swimmers will be seen in action at the War Memorial natatorium this evening in the opening events of the Hui Makani's three day outdoor swimming meet. The first race starts at 7:45 o'clock.

Several feature events for both men and women are on the opening program. The first swim will be the 1,500 meter event in which Maurice Furusho and Noboru Hamada of Hui Makani are favorites. Other outstanding swimmers in this event are K. Rokuhara of Nuuanu Y and G. Shiraki of the 40 and 8 club.

The 100 meter freestyle swim, also on tonight's program, is expected to be hotly contested. W. Waidlich of the Army, Melvin Paoa of Citywide, Furusho and Hamada of 40 and 8 and other star swimmers will perform.

Among the unattached swimmers who are expected to make a bid for first place in the century swim are Jimmy Hurd and Wilbur Craw.

One of the features of the evening will be the diving competition in which Alvarez of the Army will perform against Rutherford, Roosevelt high school star.

The 100 meter backstroke swim for men is another important event on the program.

The 200 meter breaststroke and the 400 meter relay are the feature events for women swimmers. Competing in these will be such stars as Jennie Woodd, Gladys Slaght, Mildred Slaght Hooper, Betty Stevenson and Rose Shimamura.
