Leave Honolulu on the steamer Waialeale at 7:30 P. M. Friday, August 3rd, for Kona. Arrive Kealahou Bay at 8:30 A. M. the following morning in excellent position to view the Outrigger Canoe Races, a revival of the sport of Hawaiian Kings. After the races passengers are landed at Kaawaloa, where stands the monument of Hawaii's great discoverer, Captain James Cook. Picnic luncheon will then be served, after which passengers will recross Kealahou Bay to Napoopoo, where an auto tour to Honaunau begins. Visit the ancient City of Refuge and other interesting sights, then on to Kealahou through the famous Kona coffee district to Huehue and continue over the 1801 flow of Hualalai to Puuwaawaa. The cars will then return to Kona Inn on Kailua Bay, where the passengers after a short rest will attend the Hawaiian Luau and Dances in the royal palace grounds. Following the luau a Hawaiian Pageant will be staged on the beautiful grounds of the Kona Inn with music and dancing. Board the steamer at Kailua midnight for Honolulu, arriving back Sunday, August 5, at 11:30 A. M., after two glorious days of thrills.
