

OAHU CREWS IN SHAPE FOR KONA RACES

Eighteen members of the woman crews of the Outrigger Canoe club and Hui Nalus, including chaperons, left at 10 a. m. today on the Humuula to vie for laurels in the second annual Kealakekua bay canoe paddling regatta, slated Saturday.

When these Honolulu woman boatloads reach Kona early tomorrow, the stage will have been all set for the races as all other crews, representing Hawaii, Molokai and Oahu are now encamped at Keauhou, Kona, awaiting the starter's gun.

The Oahu girls went through their final workout yesterday and their handlers pronounced them in first class physical condition to compete.

Likewise, reports from Kona stated that the men rowers of the Outrigger Canoe club, Hui Nalus and Queen's Surfriders are in excellent shape and in confident spirits.

Officials of the Inter-Island Steam Navigation stated this morning that there are a few reservations left on the excursion boat Waialeale which departs at 7:30 p. m. tomorrow for the scene of the races.
