

CANOE RECORDS SURE TO FALL

1934 Crews Reported to Be Capable of Toppling Old Race Marks

The six records established in the first annual canoe paddling program last year are expected to be shattered tomorrow when the crews representing Oahu, Molokai, and the Big Island vie for the coveted honors on Kealakekua Bay.

During trial spins, the Outrigger crews and other contenders are said to have bettered the existing times.

Records at stake in tomorrow's events are as follows:

Senior six—15 minutes 41 1-5 seconds, Outrigger.

Open two—6 minutes 19 2-5 seconds, Milolii.

Junior four—25 minutes 4 seconds, Milolii.

Junior six—10 minutes 56 seconds, Outrigger.

Women's six—1 minute 30 seconds, Milolii.

Senior four—10 minutes 16 seconds, Outrigger.
