NAPOOPOO, Hawaii, Aug. 4.—Kailua crews won the second annual canoe paddling regatta here today.

Sweeping to victory in four of the six races their triumph will be well celebrated tonight by the residents of the old home town.

In addition they tied with the Outrigger Canoe club for first in the junior six paddle event.

The official point awards were as follows:

Kailua 27, Outrigger 14, Honaunau 7, Milolii 4, Hui Nalu 1.

The Big Island fans were jubilant over their total of 38 points as against Oahu's total of 15.

The regatta, which began in rain and mist, finished in brilliant sunshine. It was estimated that between 4,000 and 5,000 spectators crowded Kealakekua bay to see the competition.

The Waialeale arrived shortly after 8 a. m. thronged to the top deck with a capacity load of Honolulu people. Other ships in the harbor included the Itasca, which
