Open two paddle—Kailua, first; Milolii, second; Outrigger, third. (Hui Nalu finished first in 7 min. 26 4-5 sec., but was disqualified for finishing in the wrong lane).

Senior four paddle—Kailua, first; Honaunau second; Outrigger, third. Time 12 min. 56 4-5 sec.
