

# MANY ENTRIES FOR SWIMMING

## Finals of Frst Meet of Series Will Be Held On Friday Evening

The Hawaiian A. A. U. Outdoor swimming championships, the trials of which are scheduled for tonight at 7:30 p. m. at the War Memorial natatorium, has drawn a score of 200 odd swimmers of Hawaii representing the Army, Hui Makani, University of Hawaii, 40 and 8 and the Citywide A. C.

The first of the series of four meets will be Friday night at the natatorium.

Events on the program Friday evening include: Diving 3 meter board open, men; 1,500 meter open swim, men, Hawaiian championship; 300 meter freestyle open, women, Hawaiian championship; 50 meter freestyle, girls 13 years of age; 50 meter freestyle, boys 13 years of age; 200 meter freestyle novice, men; 100 meter freestyle, boys 10 years of age; 300 meter individual medley junior, men; 100 meter backstroke novice, women; 100 meter breaststroke novice, men; 100 meter breaststroke open, women, Hawaiian championship; 400 meter relay novice, women; 300 meter medley relay novice, men; 400 meter relay open, men.

The crack Army team, 1934 indoor champions, will bring to the fore such star performers as Charlie Tannehill, Reynor, Waidlich, Lt. Timberlake, Lt. Webster, Eddie Alvarez, diving, champ who has already gained national recognition, together with others who are capable of registering respectable time in their various events.
