The army has qualified a trio of swimmers for the frog-style event, and the natator who is conceded some chance of victory is W. Waidlich. On the other hand the Hui Makani will have as its standard bearers such formidable swimmers as Bernard Ho, Philip Kane, Dan Toomey and A. Toomey. The 40 and 8 club will have Matsuo vying for honors.

The 400-meter freestyle should be a close race with the leading natators entered. The Army will have Tannehill, Raynor and Waidlich; the Hui Makani, Furusho and Hamada; the 40 and 8, Nakamura, Shiraki and Sakamoto, and the University of Hawaii, Kuramoto and Scott.

All of them are powerful swimmers, and every indication points to a hard fought race.

There are no trophies offered for the women, but they will not be neglected. Three titular events are slated to be held for them and one of them will be the diving from the three-meter board. This is the first time in some time that local women will compete in the diving.
