

Deans Sponsoring Special Swims On Thanksgiving Day

In conjunction with the annual Outrigger Canoe club Thanksgiving Day, November 29, swims, the Associated Students of the University of Hawaii will sponsor an open water swim, open to any swimmer at all over a course that will have its finish at the front of the Royal Hawaiian hotel.

The races will range from several hundred yards to the one and a quarter mile jaunt. Starting points will be altered to bring the finish always to the Royal Hawaiian hotel front.

Events will include both men and women individual races.

The one and a quarter mile swim, which starts at the Castle surfs outside the Elks' club, will be the blue ribbon event open to men alone. For the women the blue ribbon event will be the half mile swim starting in front of the public baths.

Other races are also listed on the program. Entries will have to file their intention of swimming before November 26, the day on which entries close at 4 p. m. with Theodore (Pump) Searle at the University of Hawaii.

Medals and trophies are in store for respective winners.
