

# MEET TO BE OVER PERIOD OF 4 WEEKS

**Mermen and Mermaids Are Urged To Start Training For Races Slated in April**

It's a far cry between now and middle April but it is not too early to talk about the 1935 Hawaiian Indoor Swimming championships.

Theodore (Pump) Searle, chairman of the local AAU aquatic committee, today announced that the annual events will be conducted in three months at the University of Hawaii tank and urges that the mermen and mermaids start training.

This year's championships will be held over a period of four weeks, as last season. They are expected to be over in plenty of time before the Yale or Interscholastic swimfest in late May.

The indoor meet would give many of the swimmers a chance to work into the peak of condition for the prep program, Searle pointed out.

#### For All Swimmers

As last year, the big program of events will include those for men and women representing the senior and junior divisions.

Exact dates for the meets have not been determined but from present indications the races will start April 19 with the initial meet to be followed with the second on April 26, the third on May 3 and the fourth on May 10.

These dates, however, are not definite and subject to change by the committee. The exact dates will be decided upon in a few days when Chairman Searle finds out whether the army will be able to participate.

#### Army Sure To Compete

The army squad won the title last year and is expected to have a stronger team this season. It is a certainty to defend the championship unless maneuvers interfere.

100 yard freestyle for women.

100 yard freestyle for men.

400 yard relay for men.

Besides the above events, there will be special races for the service and for children and exhibitions.

Some of the clubs who are sure of entering the meet include the University of Hawaii, Hui Makani, Outrigger Canoe club, Citywide A. A., 40 & 8 club from the American Legion, Nuuanu Y, Central Y, Army.
