

INDOOR SWIM DATES ARE SET

Many Organizations Are To Compete; Army Unsure; Hui Makanis Withdraw

Theodore (Pump) Searle, member of the Hawaiian AAU swimming committee, and graduate manager of the University of Hawaii, which is sponsoring the program, announced that the annual indoor championships will be staged on April 5, April 12, April 19 and April 26.

The events will be held at the University of Hawaii pool, and the following clubs have already signified their intention of competing: University of Hawaii, 40 and 8 club, Outrigger Canoe club, Nuuanu Y, Palama and Citywide A.A.

The Army, defending champion, is unsure of competing due to maneuvers. The Hui Makanis still holds a grudge against the local AAU, and stated that they will not enter.

Other organizations, such as the Central Y, the ACA, University Alumni, Aloha Amateurs and outside island unattached swimmers are expected to compete.

Searle appeared undismayed because of the Hui Makanis' intention, and said:

"If Harvey Chilton's boys think they are going to gain anything by staying out, they have another guess coming. Personally, I'd like to have the Hui Makanis compete, but if they are so small as to let a trifling matter keep their athletes out, they might as well quit swimming altogether."
