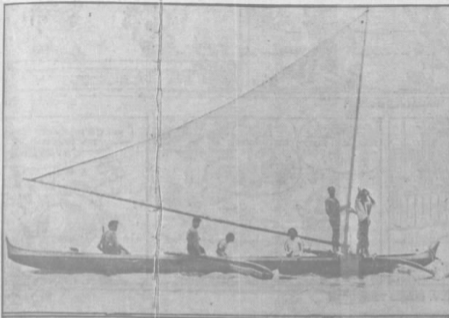
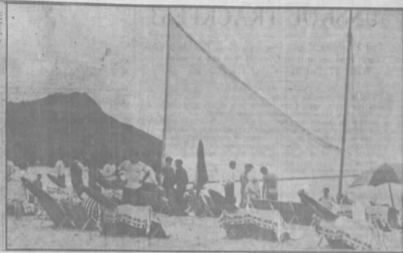


Canoeists Finesse Paddles For Sails For Sabbath Race
