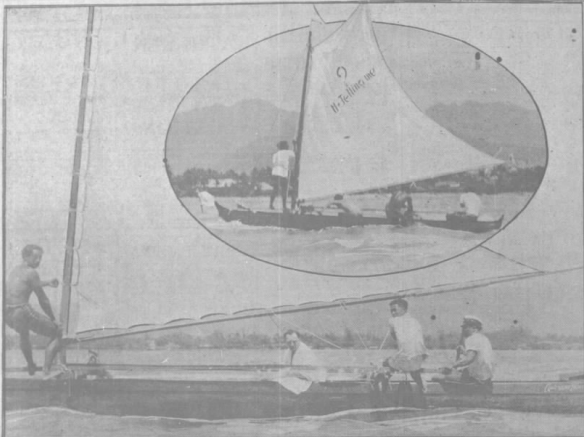


## Scenes From Sailing Races Sunday At Wiakiki Beach
