

# BEST VOLLISTS TO SHOW STUFF IN '35 SERIES

Opening Listed Next Tuesday At Central Y; 5 Strong Squads Enter

Rosters and a revised schedule of the Hawaiian AAU senior volleyball league, which opens activities next Tuesday with all games at the Central Y gymnasium, were announced today by Manuel M. Ferreira, chairman of the committee in charge of the series.
