

# SWIMMERS TO ENTER EVENTS MEMORIAL DAY

Entry Blanks Will Be Issued  
Shortly; Three Events On  
Program

Preliminary plans are being completed for the staging of the annual Memorial Day swim events sponsored by The Honolulu Star-Bulletin at the War Memorial natatorium.

Announcement will be made, in a short while, that entrants may call for entry blanks.

The program of events, as has been held for the past number of years, consists of an 880 yard women's open, men's senior and men's junior mile freestyle swims.

Last year Olga Clark, Outrigger Canoe club mermaid, shattered her own record of the year previous in the 880 yard swim. She negotiated the half mile in 13 minutes 6.8 seconds, some 11.8 seconds better than her old mark.

Maurice Furusho of the Hui Makani captured the senior men's mile event last year in the time of 24 minutes and 16 seconds.

Eddie Nakamura, swimming for the 40 and 8 club, took first honors in the junior men's mile event, chalking up a time of 24 minutes 35.6 seconds.

Valuable medal rewards will be presented by The Star-Bulletin to the victors in the swims this year.

It is expected that a large field of contestants will file entry blanks later.

Annually this swimming attraction has been able to induce the best natators on the island to take part.
