surfboards and some outrigger canoes followed; the Outrigger Canoe club was organized, and the art of surfing was saved.

"The Outrigger Canoe club "The Outrigger Canoe club was conceived as an unselfish plan, not only to give all an equal opportunity to enjoy Hawaiian water sports, but also to provide a spot where at all times the stranger might enjoy the sight of a bit of old Hawaii, and the sport of surfixing, the fame of which has gone round the world and become one of our chief assets."
