

Canoe Enthusiasts To Meet Today On Plans For Regatta

Officials representing the Hawaiian Canoe association and the Waikiki clubs that will compete in the big regatta in Honolulu Harbor Sunday will meet at noon today at the Outrigger Canoe club to map out final plans for the elimination races.

While officials meet today and approve plans which have been drafted by the committee in charge, crews from Outrigger, Hui Nalu and Queen's Surf will begin to put on the finishing touches to their training in preparation for the battle for positions in the Kona races August 24.

Considerable interest in the local regatta is being shown here and preparations are being made

to accommodate a large crowd on Pier 2 Sunday when the races are scheduled to be held.

IS FUND DRIVE

Funds raised at Sunday's regatta will be used to defray the expenses of the crews when they invade Kona next month. A nominal charge of twenty-five cents will be levied for spectators. Automobiles will be admitted to the pier for the same charge.

Final training preparations are being conducted under strict secrecy at the three camps and while rumors have floated across Waikiki about the prowess of the various crews, until the canoes skim out to the start of the race
