

Final Arrangements Made For Canoe Regatta Sunday

With the big Honolulu harbor elimination canoe regatta only four days away, officials of the three competing clubs from Wai-kiki met yesterday to lay final plans, adopt the list of officials and agree on the order of events.

There will be seven races on the program which will start promptly at 9:30 a. m. off Pier 2 and, according to gossip along the beach front, each of the three clubs will throw powerful crews into the battle for preferential position in the Kona races which follow August 24.

The blue ribbon senior six

event, victory in which carries with it the mythical title of Wai-kiki champions for 1935, will be the fourth race on the program. The morning's activities will commence with the kids' 6, in which paddlers who have not yet reached their 15th birthday will be eligible to compete. All three clubs possess doughty kids' crews and this opening event is scheduled to be one of the outstanding races of the day.

Following the kids' event the junior fours will speed over the mile and a half course from Pier
