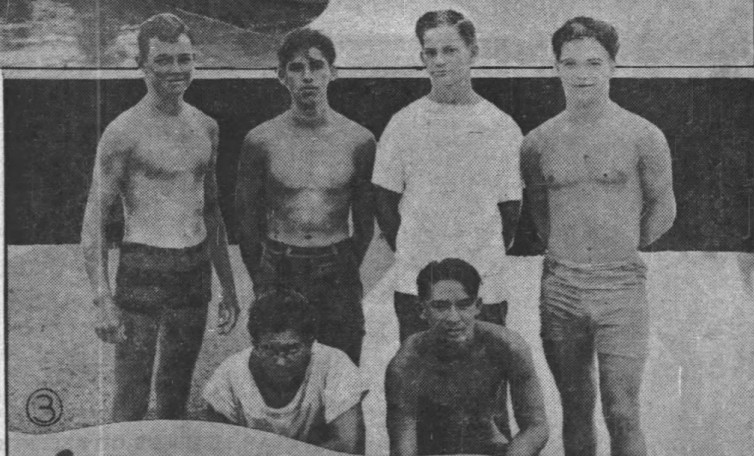


Husky Paddlers Ready to Go In Race Tomorrow
