

Outrigger Lineup Is Still Unsettled As Regatta Nears

With the big Honolulu elimination canoe regatta only 24 hours distant, Coach "Dad" Center of Outrigger Canoe club announced yesterday that the battle for positions in the OCC boats was so keen he would not make a final selection of the crews until after a final warm-up this afternoon.

Coach Center expressed confidence that the crews which will be finally selected will be the strongest ever sent into a race by the old beach club and said that his senior six would force its rivals to smash all existing records to win.

The boys' six has been definitely picked, Center said, and will line up against Hui Nalu's crack six as follows: Bob Vanek, Donald Strench, Joseph Daniels, Paul Braley, Earl Smith and George Stepp with the latter in the important No. 6 position.
