

Yates Announces Lineups Of Crews For Kona Races

HILO, Aug. 14.—Subject, as usual, to possible changes before the day of the races, the seven crews which will man the Honaunau boats in the Kona outrigger canoe races at Kailua bay August 24 were revealed today by Julian R. Yates, Kona political and civic leader and coach of his rowing club.

Made up of husky young men from Honaunau, Napoopoo, Kealakekua, Kei and Hookena, the six male crews have been going at it along the Kona shore, working in wet and dry weather, when the sea is calm and when it is rough, getting into fine condition in their drive to capture supremacy in the third annual races.

Aided by Bill Thompson in coaching, Yates has been working his wahine and kane boats regularly until the prospects are especially bright to meet whatever challenge will be forthcoming from the Honolulu paddlers.

EXPECTS FEW CHANGES

In speaking of his lineup, Yates said that although one or two changes may be made between now and August 24, the lineups of the different boats are practic-

ally set. This includes his girl crew as well as the six men crews.
