

LAST OF OAHU CREWS SAILING ON THE ITASCA

Queen's Surfers and Outriggers Leave Thursday For the Kona Races

Tomorrow heralds the departure of the last of the Oahu crews for the Kona races. Leaving on the Itasca will be the entire Queen's Surf outfit and some of the Outrigger boys.
