

Canoe Race Honors Won By Honaunau

Julian Yates' Crews Capture Six Out of Eight Events at Kailua

Honolulu Clubs Each Win One Compet in Stiff Competition

KAILUA, Kona, Aug. 24 (By Radiophone) — An ambition of three years was realized on historic Kailua Bay this morning when Julian Yates, hard working and persistent coach of Honaunau's great collection of canoe crews, saw his selections sweep across the bay in one of the most spectacular victories ever scored in Hawaiian sports.

For three years, since canoe racing was revived as a major sport of the islands, Yates has toiled down in Honaunau trying to build a winning combination. For two years, disappointment and stark defeat haunted Honaunau, but today the Julian Yates trained and coached crews were supreme.

In their hour of triumph, these sturdy Honaunau crews were in themselves a splendid tribute to this human dynamo, to whom Kona has looked upon for more than a quarter of a century as its athletic leader, and not one of the six rivals of Honaunau today begrudged Julian Yates and his crews their great achievement.

Honaunau's victory was sensational. They won six out of the eight races, including the grudge race among the consolation crews
