Garden Islanders To Enter Two Crews In Races Here

Expectations that the all-Territory canoe regatta to be held in Honolulu harbor on Kamehameha Day will be the biggest event of its kind in modern Hawaiian history were given additional justification yesterday when it was learned that Kauai will enter a second crew in the aquatic classic which will get under way promptly at 2 p.m. June 11.

set for this year, it was announced that the Honaunau crew will arrive in Honolulu at 8 a.m. today aboard the Inter-Island steamer Humuula.
