Harmony emerged out of the good fellowship inspired by the lau-lau and sandwiches of yesterday's luncheon meeting between Julian Yates of Kona, Henry Blake of Kauai and the local members of the Kamehameha Day canoe regatta committee.

Yates, leader of last year's victorious Honaunau crew, left the meeting with every concession his paddlers had demanded under the terms of their recent protest firmly tucked away in his diplomatic pocket.

The Kauai contestants, who will enter two crews in the canoe

classic June 11, had no "beefs" according to Blake, and will be on hand bright and early Sunday morning to begin training in local waters.
