

# Festivities Arranged For Kamehameha Day, June 11

Preparations for the celebration here all day Thursday of the centennial of King Kalakaua and the bicentennial of King Kamehameha are proceeding with alacrity as the city prepares to drop all its cares for one day of festivity. Visitors from the outside islands are already arriving.

The big day will be heralded by two dances Wednesday evening. The canoe regatta committee is sponsoring a benefit dance at 8 in the evening at the Outrigger Canoe club. The paddlers from the outside islands will be the guests at the dance, although their coaches will be on hand to be sure the athletes go home early. The Hawaiian Civic club's annual holoku ball will begin at 8:30 in the evening at the Royal Hawaiian hotel.

The curiosity of Honoluluans has been piqued by the evidence to be seen of the preparations for the three phases of the program for Thursday. Barges have appeared in the Ala Wai canal and bleachers have sprung up on the banks near the Ala Moana Rd. bridge. This bridge has been closed to traffic so that it may be decorated as the throne for the queen of the water pageant.

2:30 p. m.—Inter-island canoe regatta in the harbor. Seats on Pier 2.

6 p. m.—National broadcast of Hawaiian music by troupes from various islands from beneath the banyan tree in the capitol grounds.

8 p. m.—Water pageant on the Ala Wai between the Kalakaua and Ala Moana bridges. Floats for each island.

### Friday

6 p. m.—Luau at Pier 9 for the participants and helpers in the parade, races and pageant.
