

Many Entries Expected For Swim Events

Annual Thanksgiving Day Competition On Tap At Ala Moana

A HUNDRED or more swimmers will participate in the annual Thanksgiving Day swims, which will be held this year in the Ala Moana channel, according to Theodore Searle, who has charge of the event, which will be sponsored by the University of Hawaii.

From the University of Hawaii alone, a great many natators, both men and women, will enter. Olga Clarke, best woman swimmer in the Islands today, will represent the Outrigger Canoe club. Many other leading swimmers of Honolulu are looked for to vie for honors.

Formerly the swims were held off the beach at Waikiki. This year they will be held off the Ala Moana park and the progress of each race will be visible to the spectators from the shore. Searle said a large crowd will witness the annual swims.

In all, five races will be held. For men, the events will be senior mile, junior half-mile, and novice quarter-mile and for women the senior half-mile and novice quarter-mile will be staged.
