

Canoe Races Draw Crowd

Hui Nalu Paddlers Win Two of Four Events

While thousands of malihinis and kamaainas watched from the sands of Waikiki yesterday afternoon, sturdy junior and senior paddlers of the Beach Patrol, Outrigger Canoe club and the Hui Nalu raced three of the latest streamline model outrigger canoes for cash prizes offered by the Royal Hawaiian hotel.

The course was approximately a half mile long, extending from the Royal Hawaiian hotel to the Waikiki Inn.

The two-paddle and junior races were over a half-mile course, while the four and six-paddle races were a mile.

Promptly at 3 p. m. the three sleek canoes, manned by two men each from the three beach clubs, answered the starting gun fired by Sally Hale, captain of the Beach Patrol, who had arranged the competition.
