Six Events Slated To Be

FOUR CLUBS ENTER

A canoe regatta will be held on the Ala Wai canal on June 11 and the annual classic will be sponsored by the Kamaaina Beachcombers' Hui which put on the Duke P. Kahanamoku Indoor swimming meet with great success a few weeks ago.

Six events are listed for the regatta. They are one mile junior four paddles, one mile senior six paddles, one mile junior six paddles, half-mile women six paddles, quarter mile six paddles for boys under 17 years of age, and one mile senior four paddles.

The first event is slated to start at 3 o'clock.

Four clubs are expected to vie for honors. Outrigger Canoe Club, Hui Nalu, Queen's Surf, and Healani. However, as yet the Healani entry is doubtful. The committee in charge of the meet is hoping that the Blue and Whites will definitely enter crews in the regatta.

All the crews will go into strenuous training shortly. Every club is reported to have strong combinations and indications are that the races will all be hardfought.

Considerable interest has been worked up in canoe racing in recent years and a huge gathering will no doubt witness the coming regatta.
