

# FINAL EVENTS IN SWIM MEET THIS EVENING

The Hawaiian AAU indoor championship swimming meet continues tonight at Punahou tank with 15 more events listed to take place, starting at 7:30.

Seven senior championship races are scheduled to show tonight in both women's and men's events.

Records most likely to go under the boards this evening are the 100 yard women's backstroke and the 300 yard women's individual medley races.

In both these events Midge Garnsey of Citywide rules as the heavy favorite.

Other titular senior races listed are the 300 yard individual medley for men, diving for men, 220 yard freestyle for women, the century women's crawl and the 220 yard men's freestyle race.

### **Strong Favorite**

Olga Clarke of Citywide AA looms as the strong favorite to cop the century wahine crawl affair while Takeshi Hirose of Maui looks a cinch to take the furlong men's crawl race. Barney Pung is not entered in this race.

It is very unlikely that Hirose's winning time tonight for the 220 yard event will threaten John Macionis' Hawaiian standard of 2 minutes 13.2 seconds established in 1935.

However, the 15 year old Maui lad has been improving by leaps and bounds in the past two years and looks to stand an even chance of bettering or equaling his 2 minutes 16 seconds time made for the furlong in Maui about a week back.

### **Favor Nakama**

Kiyoshi Nakama of Maui is the standout favorite to win the men's individual medley race of 300 yards with last year's winner, D. K. Martin, expected to come in a good second.

Olga Clarke is favored to take first in the furlong race for women.

The century crawl event for junior men looms as a hard fought struggle with James Armitage and Peter Powlison expected to battle it out for top position.
