WIN CANOE

RACE MEET

Winning three out of the five events held, including the blue ribbon senior six, the Hui Nalu canoe paddlers captured the Kamehameha Day regatta on the Ala Wai Saturday afternoon.

Several hundred spectators lined both sides of the Waikiki canal to take in the races, sponsored by the Kamaaina Beachcombers' Hui.

Racing over a mile course, the Hui Nalu seniors, made up of J. Davis, J. Dickson, D. Aona, Ah Kong Pang, Wilfred Paul and J. Insberg, paddled over the finishing line first.

The time was 7 minutes 31.3 seconds.

Outrigger's two crews finished second and third.

Hard Fought

The junior six event was hard fought with the Hui Nalus winning in the time of 8 minutes 3.4 seconds from the Outriggers. The Nalu lineup was A. Love, D. Kalakaua, Z. Roski, C. Boyd, P. Silva and J. Kaaua.

Kids six paddle (half mile)— Won by Outrigger; second, Hui Nalu; third, Hui Nalu. Time, 3 minutes 53.2 seconds.

Junior six paddles (one mile)— Won by Hui Nalu; second, Outrigger; third, Hui Nalu; fourth, Outrigger. Time 8 minutes 3.4 seconds.

Senior four paddles (one mile)— Won by Hui Nalu; second, Outrigger. Time, 8 minutes 36.5 seconds.
