

Oahu Canoe at Molokai After Rough Voyage

KAUNAKAKAI, Molokai, Oct. 13.—The outrigger canoe Ka Moi, which arrived from Oahu at 1:05 this afternoon, left for Mala at 2:20 after refueling. The crew, which had lunch here, expects to reach Mala in three hours.

KAUNAKAKAI, Molokai, Oct. 13.—The 35½ foot outrigger canoe Ka Moi, which left from Waikiki, Oahu, for Maui at 5:30 this morning, arrived here at 1:05 this afternoon.

Members of the crew said they had a rough trip, bailed water all the way, but were all "O. K."

Four members of the Waikiki beach patrol comprise the crew, Sally Hale, Tommy Kiakona, Harry Robello and William (Chick) Daniels Jr. Their craft is powered by a 16 horsepower outboard motor.

The quartet will remain on Maui until Sunday when they'll begin the return trip to Waikiki.
