

4 Beach Boys Reach Molokai In Canoe Jaunt

KAUNAKAKAI, Molokai,
Oct. 13.—The outrigger canoe
Ka Moi, manned by four mem-
bers of the Waikiki Beach Pa-
trol, was delayed here by rough
weather, but plans to leave in
time to arrive at Lahaina at
7:30 a.m. Friday.

The canoe, powered by a 16-
horsepower outboard motor, ar-
rived from Oahu at 1:05 p.m.
after a six - and - a - half-hour
crossing from Waikiki. Rough
seas were encountered in the
channel, necessitating constant
bailing.

The boys planned to leave for
Lahaina at 2:20 p.m. but were
forced to postpone their start
because of rough weather.

Making the trip to attend the
Maui county fair are Sally Hale,
Tommy Kiakona, Harry Robello
and William (Chick) Daniels,
Jr. They plan to start their re-
turn trip on Sunday.
