

# Outrigger Arrives At Lahaina Safely

WAILUKU, Maui, Oct. 14.—Four seafaring Honoluluans who wanted to get to the 21st Maui county fair the hard way arrived at Lahaina at 8 a. m. today in a 32½ foot outrigger canoe, Ka Moi powered by an out-board motor.

Headed by Sally Hale, the group included Tommy Kiakona, William Daniels Jr. and Harry Robello.

They left Honolulu on Thursday, arriving at Kaunakakai shortly after 1 p. m. After spending the night on Molokai, they left for Lahaina at 6 a. m. and made the trip in the fast time of two hours.

"We were fortunate in having good weather," Mr. Hale said.

The quartet is planning to leave Sunday morning and make the return trip direct, if weather permits.
