Club Lease Vote Is Due

Outrigger Canoe Members Ask Aid In Rental Boost

The Outrigger Canoe club will meet Friday night to vote on acceptance of a 25-year lease from Hawaiian Hotels, Ltd., which would insure continuance of the famous beach organization at its familiar Waikiki seaside location, Walter Macfarlane club president, disclosed yesterday.

For the past three months doubts were felt among officers of the Outrigger whether the club would be able to remain at Waikiki in the face of an increase in rent asked by the Queen Emma estate. The rent for the sand and grass club site between the Moana and Royal Hawaiian hotels was boosted from approximately \$250 to a figure reported to be \$1,000 a month.

Hotels To Aid

At this juncture the assistance of Hawaiian Hotels, Ltd., was asked to keep the renowned organization at the heart of Waikiki beach activity on a longterm lease basis.

Hawaiian Hotels will sign an agreement with estate trustees to pay the stipulated rent, provided the Outrigger Canoe club will sublet the property for 25
