## Paddling Program for Sunday Afternoon Given

The complete program of the special paddling meet off Waikiki beach Sunday, sponsored by the Hui Nalu and Outrigger Canoe clubs, was announced this morning.

The events commence at 3 in the afternoon and besides the major 'Award, the Bill Leeds' trophy, cash prizes will be at stake.

Activities will start with a canoe paddling race between the Hui Nalu team in Black Maria and the Beach Patrol in the Ka Mol. The affair is from Steiners to the Royal Hawaiian hotel.

The main event is a surfboard paddling race over a third of a mile course. The winner gets Leeds' trophy for a year.

The cup will become the permanent property of the contestant who wins the race thrice,

Cash Prices at Stake Cash prizes will be awarded the first four events. In the third race a compact is also offered.

Besides the Leeds' trophy, med-

als to the first three winners will be presented in the last race.

It is planned to stage the Leeds' paddling program annually on the fourth Sunday of January.

The program reads:

1. Canoe race between Hui Nalu and Beach Patrol.

2. Special race for hollow boards with requirements as advertised for those who have trained.

Course—from Royal to around launch anchored outside first break—around Moana side of guard tower and finish in front of Royal.

3. Tandem race. Visitor wahines only as partners. Course—from Moana to Royal.

4. Relay race between Hui Nalu and Beach Patrol-three man team-100 yards each man.

Course-start in front of Moana to Royal.

5. Cup race for redwood boards only. Bill Leeds' trophy: permanent property when won three times. Medals to first, second and third places.

Course—from Royal Hawaiian hotel to outside of new lifeguard tower to around far guard sign in front of Steiners and finish at Royal.
