

Outrigger Canoe Club Plans Modern Structure

During the coming summer the world famous Outrigger Canoe club at Waikiki Beach will rebuild its entire club and service facilities. Herewith are shown tentative plans of the new layout for the first time, and the directors, due to the fact that this club has a community value as well as being semi-private, are anxious to secure suggestions and criticisms of a constructive nature.

The upper sketch shows the proposed front of the club as it faces the beach. It will provide space for housing seven canoes, an office for the Waikiki Beach Patrol, and a soda fountain and light lunch facilities.

On the second floor will be a covered pavilion from which a marvelous view of Waikiki Beach and its activities can be secured. The balance of the space will be devoted to sun-bathing facilities, with possibly cabanas and beach lounging equipment.

On the grounds, as indicated in the lower sketch, there will be men's lockers at the right as you enter; women's and children's locker rooms at the left.

Facilities Restricted

It is planned to make use of interior property as far as is possible for sports purposes, including volley ball, hand ball, paddle tennis and badminton, thereby offering varied sports attractions which should interest and better serve the club's membership.

Arrangements have been

made whereby the club will be restricted to members and their guests only. The general public will not have free access to the grounds as has been the case in the past, either from Kalakaua avenue or from the beach.

The plans shown herewith are not final. The Directors are anxious to get suggestions, which will enable this famous institution of Hawaii to better serve the purpose for which it was founded which was to create an opportunity for the youth of Hawaii to learn about and enjoy the beach sports for which Waikiki is justly world famous.

The first hundred feet from Kalakaua have been released by the Outrigger Canoe Club to the Territorial Hotels Company, Ltd., who unquestionably will erect store buildings. This will necessitate finding suitable parking facilities for club members in the neighborhood of the club. The property involved is too valuable to be used by the club for parking facilities.

Fosters Sports

The Outrigger Canoe Club has been responsible for entertaining many thousands of world famous visitors in the past. As a result of the vision of Alexander Hume Ford, J. P. Cooke, W. R. Castle, Al Castle, Frank C. Atherton, J. R. Galt, Clarence Cooke, E. Faxon Bishop and many others, the club was established in 1908, and is directly responsible for the renewed interest in canoeing and surf board riding, and has, as well, been responsible for the development of many of Hawaii's leading swimmers.

The new club house will be on the site now occupied by the Uluniu Club. The Uluniu Club will be given space between the Outrigger and the Royal Hawaiian Hotel, approximately where the Outrigger's hau lanais are at the present time. The Uluniu Club will be relocated in the near future.
