

TOPPINGS IN CANOE RACES

The Toppings top the list of entries for the outrigger canoe races this Sunday at the beach of Waikiki in front of the Royal Hawaiian hotel.

These contests are a continuation of the tournament for the Pualani Topping trophy, a prize donated by Gloria Baker Topping.

One of the canoes entered in the featured race at 10 in the morning includes Henry J. (Bob) Topping, skipper; another includes Doris Duke Cromwell and a third with Jayne (Leilani) Topping.

At 2:30 in the afternoon there will be a canoe race from in front of the Royal Hawaiian hotel out beyond the surf and return. This race will be open to all Hawaiian outrigger canoes carrying crews of six or more. Merchandise prizes will be awarded.

Immediately following the canoe race will be a surfboard paddling race on regular tandem balsa surfboards for men 35 years and over.

After the surfboard race there will be surfboard polo between the Hui Nalu club and the Queen's Surf club. The surfboard polo series is
