

Canoe Races Begin Today

Waikiki Will Be Scene Of Sailing Events For Topping Trophy

The beach of Waikiki will be the scene of the first of a series of outrigger canoe sailing races this morning for the Pualani Topping trophy.

The race, which tops the weekly program of water sports, starts at 10 a.m. and is expected to last about three hours.

Nine crews will take part in this novel event. Skippers and crews have put in many long hours during the past week getting their gear in order and a spirited battle looms for first honors.

The program in front of the Royal Hawaiian starts at 2:30 p.m. The number on the bill is a canoe race starting from the beach, out to the surf and return. This will be followed by a surfboard passing race for men over 35.
