Maui To Send 7 To Detroit

The island of Maui plans to send a delegation of seven men to the national AAU swimming championships next month in Detroit, E. L. Damkroger, valley island sports official disclosed yesterday.

Damkroger informed Pump Searle, of the AAU registration committee, of such plans by Inter-Island radiophone yesterday. Maui was awarded \$640 toward their expenses by the Junior Chamber of Commerce and Damkroger said the balance needed to finance the trip would be raised on the island.

Personnel of the team was not divulged. It is expected, however, that five swimmers — K. Nakama, T. Hirose, Benny Castor, Bill Neunzig and Jose Balmores, Coach Soichi Sakamoto and a manager would comprise the party.

Damkroger said that Maui would be glad to have Barney Pung or any other local swimmers join their party. Pung was voted \$160 toward his expenses by the Jaycee. It is possible that the remainder will come from the AAU.
