Barge And Canoe Compe-

The Japanese Rowing club will be represented in the senior barge race of the Pacific Aquatic Carnival regatta next Sunday morning in the Moana channel. It will be the first time since the club was organized several years ago that the Japanese will have a senior crew. It is composed mostly of oarsmen who rowed in the Junior race last year.

Navy will race in the senior, novice, and intermediate events. The Tars are expected to move their training quarters from Pearl Harbor to the Ala Wai next Wednesday.

The line of recall will be marked 50 yards from the starting point. A recall of crews for any reason will not be allowed after the first crew passes this mark.

In the canoe paddling races, the Hui Nalu and Outrigger Canoe club will vie for honors. The Nalus will have two crews in each race.
