

Beach Club Expansion Plans Told

Outrigger Clubhouse To Include Lounge, Cafe, Grill, Terrace; New Dues Listed

Announcement was made yesterday by officials of the famous Outrigger Canoe club of expanded facilities and new rates which will be offered the club's membership. Recently members of the club authorized a bond issue of \$90,000 to finance this renovation and reorganization.

On the ground floor of the large clubhouse to be erected on the beach front will be an attractive cocktail lounge, lanai cafe, terrace overlooking the beach, an informal grill and fountain for bathers, the general office, canoe storage and adjacent headquarters for the Waikiki Beach Patrol, and surfboard lockers.

Second-Floor Lounge

The second floor will boast a large glass-enclosed lounge, available for luncheons, teas, dinners, late suppers, private parties and the like. Immediately adjoining will be a large open deck for sun bathing which may also be used as extra space for entertainment when desired.

Mauka of the property will be ample locker room accommodations for men, women and boys, with commodious steel lockers, showers and complete service with attendance. Entrance will be from Kalakaua avenue.

Plans have also been made for a gymnasium with an exercise room offering private and class instructions in calisthenics and jiu jitsu, steam and cabinet baths, and massage service for both men and women.

Play Area Planned
