tions will be typically Hawaiian, Special facilities being made available to members are a registration service so that members may locate visitors, a mail service to save guests a trip to town to locate their mail, and a personal telephone service.

Negotiations are under way to locate an excellent chef so that members will be offered excellent meals at moderate prices.

Classes of memberships and their qualifications are as follows: Regular members, persons 18 years of age or over, \$10 for initiation and \$3 monthly; associate members, wives of members and persons at least 17 years of age whose monthly income doesn't exceed \$150, \$10 initiation and \$2 monthly.

Junior members, minors between 10 and 17 inclusive, \$10 initiation and \$1 monthly; Island members, residents who don't maintain their principal place of business on the Island or reside here more than six months of any calendar year, \$10 initiation and \$1.50 monthly.

Non-Resident Members

Non-resident members, those who don't reside here any more than six months in any calendar year or maintain their principal place of business here, \$10 initiation and \$5 a month when in Hawaii.

Service members, commissioned officers of the armed forces and officials of the United States temporarily stationed here and such of their relatives and families as the committee on admissions or the board of directors deems it advisable to admit, shall pay no initiation fee. Service men shall pay \$3 a month; wives, \$2 and juniors \$1.

Temporary members are those eligible to non-resident member-

ship and pay no initiation fee but \$5 a week: sustaining members, partnerships, associations and corporations, pay no initiation fee, simply \$25 per annum,

Dues for the new members will commence Jan. 1. 1940, unless the; desire to use the privileges of the club immediately. The schedule of fees, dues and costs of memberships will remain unchanged until, Dec. 31, 1939, at which time the initiation fee for regular members will be advanced to \$25.

Stress is being placed upon the associate memberships by officials of the club, who believe this offers the young business men and women excellent privileges at moderate prices.
