

# Mrs. Young, Outrigger Club Worker, Dies

Mrs. Helen A. Young, for 12 years in charge of the women's department of the Outrigger Canoe club, died at 6:20 a.m. yesterday at the Queen's hospital after an illness of several weeks' duration. She lived at 2116 Ladd lane, Pauoa, and was the widow of Henry Young.

Services will be held at 3 p.m. today at Silva's mortuary, where friends may call after 9 a. m. The funeral procession will leave the mortuary at 3:30 p.m. for the Pauoa Hawaiian church cemetery, where interment will take place.

Mrs. Young was born in Honolulu on October 12, 1890, and was almost 49 years of age. Mrs. Young was known by thousands who frequented Waikiki beach.

Her husband died about two years ago. Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Elaine Rego, and the Misses Estelle and Louise Young; a son, Henry, 19, who returned recently from Hilo to be with his mother; her parents; a sister, Mrs. Louise Aloiau, and two brothers, James and Laban Pohina.
