

Surfing Association Stages Races Today

An entry list of more than a score of the leading surfing experts of Honolulu will compete in the first Territorial Surfboard Paddling Championship, to be held today starting at 10:30 a. m. in the harbor off Pier two under the sponsorship of the Hawaiian Surfing Association.

Eight surfboard events and two outboard racing events are on the program for the day. A number of the contestants have built new boards for the occasion, in expectation of being able to use them in the California championships at Long Beach on December 5. The Association hopes to be able to send its leading performers to that meet.

Four Teams In Relay

Outrigger, Natatorium, Queen's Surf and Citywide teams have entered the mile relay event, the final race of the day, for the Recreation Commission trophy.

The meet opens at 10:30 with an outboard motor race. Following it in order are the 100 yard open for men, the women's novice, and the 220 yard event for boys under 16. A special five mile outboard race opens the second half of the program, being followed by the half-mile open race, the 440 yard relay for boys under 18, the 220 yard women's open event, the 100 yard solid redwood board race and the mile relay as the final.
